Pharaonic day #1 – visit the Great Pyramids of Giza/Sphinx, camel rides, Grand Egyptian Museum, Nile River dinner cruise

WED 22 APRIL:

Fayoum Oasis day – visit Whale Bones Valley (UNESCO World Heritage Site) via 4x4 vehicles, lunch in the desert, Premier Egyptian artist Mohammad Abla's art center, pottery village

Coptic day #1 – visit Coptic Christian Old Cairo including the Coptic Museum, Hanging Church, Ben Ezra Synagogue, Cave Church and Recycle Center, Anglican Cathedral, felucca sailboat lunch on the Nile

Coptic day #2 – visit St Anthony, the oldest monastery in the world and the art of St Paul's Monastery in the Arab Desert, lunch at a coastal resort on the Red Sea, visit with a Coptic iconographer

SAT 25 APRIL:

Pharaonic day #2 – visit Sakkara Pyramids, Necropolis & Dahshur, Wissa Wassef art center, Tanoura (whirling dervishes) show in evening

SUN 26 APRIL:

Islamic day #2 – visit El Moez Street, the ancient gate of Bab Zuweila, Tentmakers, Islamic Art Museum, fly to Luxor for 2 nights

MON 27 APRIL:

Luxor day #1 – visit the Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple, Sunset Tour of Luxor Temple

TUES 28 APRIL:

Luxor day #2 – Karnak Temple in ancient Thebes, back to Cairo for a presentation over dinner by a Sufi teacher on Sufism and a Sufi artist

WED 29 APRIL:

Desert finale - visit Anafora desert organic farm and spirituality center, shopping/packing, goodbye dinner at hotel

THURS 30 APRIL: departure (morning hotel check out required)

PAYMENTS:

After reviewing your inquiry form, we will email you further instructions on the registration process, including needed forms and payment options to submit a deposit of \$500 per person, along with a schedule of payments due. You will be able to pay via credit card (via PayPal), US check, Zelle or bank wire transfer.

- 1. \$500 deposit per person due with tour registration forms
- 2. 50% of costs due 6 months ahead of the tour
- 3. 100% of costs due 3 months ahead of the tour

CONFIRMATION AND CANCELLATION POLICY:

The \$500 deposit is nonrefundable unless the tour is cancelled or rescheduled. Payments are 50% refundable up to 6 months before the tour begins; after that, any refund will depend on someone else taking your place on the tour, or you can request to join us on a future tour within twelve months, where your installments minus the deposit and any non-refundable deposits made by the supplier, will be credited to that tour. **We strongly recommend that all participants purchase comprehensive trip cancellation and interruption insurance in the event you need to cancel your travel plans.**

Egypt requires a passport that is valid for 6 months beyond your scheduled return date. A tourist visa is required and will be arranged ahead of time and given to you by our Meet and Greet agent upon your arrival at Cairo International Airport.
